### School Review Affirmations

Last week I shared with you our commendations from the review. This week you will see our affirmations. These are structures and processes in the school that we are encouraged to continue to implement or develop further.

- The School Wide Positive Behaviours approach underpin the development of Respect for Self, Respect for others and Respect for property. Students know school behaviour expectations and consequences.
- The teachers, Learning Support Officers and students work in collaborative flexible learning spaces which facilitate team teaching and cross groupings.
- The expertise and experience of the leadership team has been effective and fully utilised to deliver the goals of the school in eLearning and in the use of evidence and data for decision making at a school and classroom level. The targeted investment in the digital environment of the school has ensured contemporary opportunities for student learning can be maximised.
- The ongoing use of Learning Intentions, Success Criteria and learning dispositions supports students in fully engaging in the proposed learning experiences. Teachers have embraced these strategies and use visual cues for students to reconnect with what is required.
- The identification of highly abled students is evident and the planning for their deeper engagement in targeted learning is being implemented.
- Structured Professional Learning Meetings for staff have ensured targeted professional learning opportunities and they have promoted professional learning conversations for all teachers.
- The work undertaken to establish a maths data wall for staff to track student progress makes growth visible from 2017 to 2018.

Recently we interviewed our new prep families for 2019 and it was enlightening to hear the reasons why they have

#### **Australian Mathematics Competition** sponsored by the Commonwealth Bank


# Wednesday 8th August

The Australian Mathematics Competition is an optional extension activity available to students in middle (Yr 3/4) and upper primary (Yr 5/6). It is a one hour math test involving 25 multiple choice and 5 questions involving a number answer, with an emphasis on problem solving strategies. Students wishing to enter the competition, which is sponsored by the Commonwealth Bank, need to place \$8.50 (competition entry fee and access to online practise program) in an envelope with your name, and the title - Math Competition, on the front of the envelope and return it to school office by 29th June.


